### Preamble

School sponsored or approved activities open for parents and general public viewing are an important part of the school experience. They offer students the opportunity to participate in a number of activities not offered during the regular school day. These activities are considered private events subject to the control of the Regina Catholic School Division (RCSD), school rules, and provincial law.

### Application

The Board grants the school administration discretion to invite individuals including parents to attend school-sponsored activities as guests of the school division.

Individuals attending school-sponsored activities as guests of the school division who

- Interfere with students or staff
- Disrupt these activities
- Are not in compliance with provincial law, school rules, or Board policies
- May, at the discretion of the school administration, Director or designate, be asked to leave and be excluded from school sponsored activities.
