## CSCC Grant Funding

- The 2021-22 initial budget changes had indicated a reduction of all CSCC grants to \$1000. This was shared with CSCCs and SBAs last spring at the CSCC Board Linkage Meeting
- However, the 2021-22 school budget did not see a reduction in the CSCC grant.

#### CSCC Grant Funding 2022-23

- 2022-23 CSCC Grants will be reviewed.
- Using Baragar and the super indicators, we set new criteria for determining grant support.



#### Baragar Super Indicators

- 1. Household income lower than \$30,000
- 2. Percentage of Indigenous families
- 3. First language not English
- 4. Labour force unemployment numbers
- 5. Community mobility moved in the last year



### CSCC Grant Expenditures

CSCC grant monies will be directed toward such expenses as:

- Parent education resources
- Communication costs
- Printing of cheques
- Collecting data
- Registration costs for workshops for CSCC members
- Honoraria for guest presenters
- Materials necessary for council operation, etc.
- Events that strengthen the home/school/parish/community bond
- Any other council development activities
- All government funds allotted to schools must be tracked according to guidelines set by the Ministry of Education.
