- b. Is there evidence of Catholic values: faith, hope, love?
- c. Is there evidence that this decision respects poverty sensitive principles of decision making?

2. Local Accountability

The following local accountability considerations must be taken:

- a. Recognized role
- b. Sensitivity to staff workload
- c. Culture of the school division
- d. Culture of expectations of the local community
- e. Resource implications (human, financial, technological, facility)
- f. Timing/scheduling factors
- g. Practicality and feasibility
- h. Impact on curriculum
